**9.** The VPNoBB connection shall be configured with following facilities:

1. One basic phone with only incoming facility is to be installed.
2. The customer will not have access to Broadband Internet.
3. The Broadband Internet will be under Business-700 plan but no user-id & password for internet will be created.
4. The VPN o BB will be of 256Kbps, Symmetric with QoS, Multicasting and necessary routings.
5. The package will support Multi-user environment.
6. The CPE must have minimum 4 Ethernet ports.
7. The VPNoBB connections must be created in "PROJECT-3". The locations which are not feasible for Project-3, VPNoBB may be created in Project 2.2 and later on to be migrated in Project-3.

**Note:**

1. As per the letter No. BSNL/BD/NIC-e-Governance/2007/Vol. I dated 11.10.2007 of BSNL H.Q., based on this single advice note, the concerned GM (BD) or the designated GM shall take the details from the intranet and communicate the requirements to concerned SSA and arrange implementation expeditiously.
2. **A consolidated payment, as per the details given above, has been collected by NTR New Delhi.** No further payment is required to be taken at SSA. The future payment will also be collected centrally by NTR on annual basis.
3. Rental Amount for Sulabh connections has also been collected centrally by NTR New Delhi. For connections provided under e-Governance, monthly rental for Modem alongwith Security deposit and Installation charges have been waived off, vide BSNL HQ circular No. BSNL/BD/e-Governance/2004 dtd. 12/04/2007 (Available on BSNL intranet under BD section).
4. **No disconnection (under DNP) of the facilities provided under this Advice Note be carried out,** unless conveyed by NTR - New Delhi.

The Installation and Commissioning is to be done on high priority and should be completed at the earliest. The date of installation of Sulabh Telephone (with Telephone No.) and VPNoBB must be conveyed to this office in the enclosed format.
